### The successful candidate will be expected to:

- Carry out world-class research in areas appropriate to the vision and purpose of the Centre, and disseminate research findings in appropriate ways, including publishing in high-impact journals
- Provide leadership in research and scholarship at national and international levels within the field of transportation engineering or transport planning
- Collaborate and network with researchers in African and other international research organisations, as well as industry
- Acquire and manage research funding
- Supervise postgraduate research students and guide post-doctoral researchers
- Contribute to teaching postgraduate and undergraduate courses

### The requirements for application include:

- A doctoral degree in the fields of transport engineering, transport planning, or a related discipline
- An outstanding track record of research-based refereed publications
- Considerable international standing in a relevant field
- A proven track record of postgraduate teaching and supervision at Master's and Doctoral level would be an advantage
- Management and administrative experience
- An ability to work collegially as part of a team
